Mexico: Attacks on Journalists in 2006



In 2006, up to 9 media workers were killed in Mexico, 3 “disappeared” and many more were harassed and threatened including reporters working for community radios. Few perpetrators have been brought to account so far for these crimes, and an overall climate of impunity predominates.

ARTICLE 19, the Global Campaign for Free Expression and the Network for the Protection of Journalists in Mexico are launching a report on Attacks on Journalists in Mexico.
